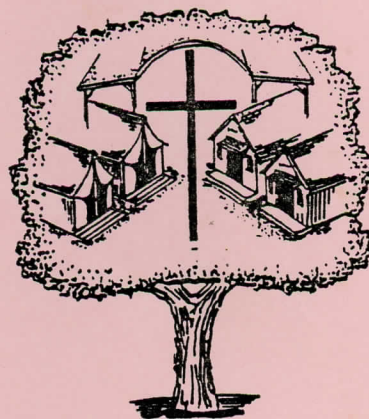

## SPEAKERS

He had a weekly radio ministry called Bible Study Time and has written commentaries on Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, James, the Epistle of John, Daniel and Revelation. He resides in Escondido, CA.

Rev. Arthur Larson has been affiliated with Global Outreach Mission since the late seventies, and continues to serve on the Global Outreach Mission Board of Directors. He has pastored churches in U. S. and Canada since 1957. Art Larson preaches Biblical Truth in an inspiring uplifting way that is well received in Bible believing churches. Art and Wanda Larson have four children. She often joins him in duets for a wonderful musical presentation.

Mr. Robert Dowie was born in Belfast, Ireland. He came to know Christ in 1946. In 1954 God called him to preach the gos-

pel in Canada with the Crystal River Quartet. Four years latter he was called to the faculty of New Brunswick Bible Institute where he was a Bible Teacher, Dean and Music Director for 34 years. In 1992 he left N.B.B.I. to engage in Bible Conference ministry. Mr. Dowie and his wife Irene have eight children and twelve grandchildren.
