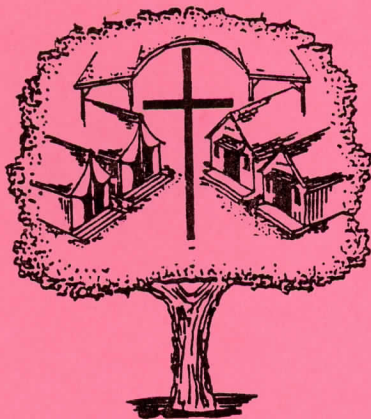

HISTORICAL

Shortly before the beginning of the 20th century, in an era when campmeetings were springing up in many places, our founder, Dr. I. A. MacDannald got the vision to start a campmeeting in the beautiful wooded area which we now occupy.

The Council of the Church of God at Washington Boro, of which Dr. MacDannald was pastor, agreed to cooperate if he could secure twenty tents and rent the ground. This came to fruition and the first camp opened with nineteen tents on Thursday evening September 7, 1892.

In 1905 the Central Manor Campmeeting Association was formed. In the same year the first tabernacle—twenty feet by fifty feet in size—was built and action was taken to build a dining hall.

Tents were used exclusively until 1926 when three cabins were built. There are now about one hundred sixty cabins.

Our present auditorium now accommodates approximately one thousand people. The dining hall is able to seat three hundred fifty at one meal.

In recent years the association has been incorporated and we now function as a non-denominational campmeeting and Bible Conference facility, where the fundamental truths of the Word of God are faithfully proclaimed.

SPEAKERS

Dr. David Clemens has been involved in a national and international Bible teaching ministry for over thirty-five years, conducting Biblical Living Skills Conferences through out the United States as well as in some twenty-eight foreign countries. Dr. Clemens was for thirty-two years missionary\Bible teacher for BCM International, Inc. and is presently Bible Teacher and President of David Clemens Bible Teaching Ministries, Inc. He is also the author of "Steps to Maturity" a 3-volume series of Biblical Studies. He has served in the pastorate and on the mission field and now resides in Marlton NJ, with his wife Janice. They have two married sons and three grandchildren.

Dr. John Fletcher has served as senior pastor of Faith Bible Church in Sterling, VA, for the past twenty-nine years. He has also served on the boards of Washington Bible College\Capital Bible Seminary, UFM International and Pioneers Mission. Dr. Fletcher has contributed articles to the "Goodnews Broadcaster" and other periodicals. Over one hundred and thirty individuals have been called from his congregation into full-time ministry. He and his wife, Francie have four sons and live in Sterling.

Dr. Charles U. Wagner is senior pastor of Calvary Baptist Church in Covington, Kentucky. He is a graduate of Tyndale College and received his D.D. Degree from Los Angeles Baptist Seminary. Dr. Wagner has many years experience as a pastor and educator having also served as president of Northwestern Baptist Seminary and Cornerstone College. Along with his pastoral ministry he is the speaker for a radio program, "At Calvary", and travels extensively in conference ministry. He and his wife, Ruth, have two married children.

Mr. Tom Telford is a sought after missions speaker and consultant for churches throughout the eastern United States and has lectured on world missions and the local church in many well known seminaries and universities including Columbia International University. After becoming a believer in later life, Tom invested his life in missions and began his ministry as a missions chairman in the local church from which God continued to bless and enlarge his ministry. He currently is the Vice President of Mobilization for United World Mission after having served 15 years with APMC (Advancing Churches In Missions Commitment). Tom has inspired, challenged, and trained hundreds of churches in missions commitment and ministry. He and his wife, Nancy, have two children and three grandchildren. Tom is also the son of the late Dr. Andrew Telford, a regular speaker here for many years.

He is professor of music at the College of the Ozarks in Missouri where he also serves as Director of Worship for the college church. Being the son of our association president, Norman Gerlach and his wife Elaine, Bruce has been a part of Camp since childhood. He and his wife Margie have two children.

Mr. Ryan Shenk is serving in his 2nd year as Worship Associate at Calvary Church in Lancaster. He is a native of Lancaster County and a graduate of Lancaster Bible College. Before coming to Calvary Church, Ryan served as music director at a church near Boston where he met his wife Aimee. (Ryan will be substituting for Bruce the first weekend.)

CONCERT

The Ted Cornell Chorale began in 1969 and has continuously ministered for over 30 years. Its members hail from 22 different churches and 30 communities in the Metropolitan New York\New Jersey area. The Chorale has performed in concert halls, churches and Bible conferences throughout the country and had the privilege of singing before 31,000 people at the Northern New Jersey Billy Graham Crusade. Its current director, Mark Schmidt, is a graduate of The King's College, and has been with the group since 1982, serving as director since 1998.
