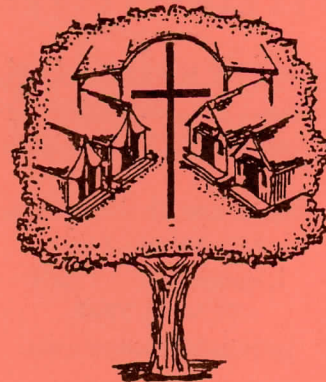

HISTORICAL

Shortly before the beginning of the 20th century, in an era when campmeetings were springing up in many places, our founder, Dr. I. A. MacDannald got the vision to start a campmeeting in the beautiful wooded area which we now occupy.

The Council of the Church of God at Washington Boro, of which Dr. MacDannald was pastor, agreed to cooperate if he could secure twenty tents and rent the ground. The first camp opened with nineteen tents on Thursday evening, September 7, 1892.

In 1905 the Central Manor Campmeeting Association was formed. In the same year the first tabernacle - twenty feet by fifty feet, was built and action was taken to build a dining hall.

Tents were used exclusively until 1926 when three cabins were built. There are now about 190 cabins.

Our present tabernacle accommodates approximately one thousand people. The dining hall is able to seat four hundred at one meal.

The camp is incorporated and functions as a non-denominational campmeeting and Bible Conference facility, where the fundamental truths of the Word of God are faithfully proclaimed.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

We Believe:

The Bible is the Word of God! It is fully inspired by God to the very words and is true in every aspect in the original writing. It is therefore the only authority for faith and practice.

God is a Triune God! There is one God existing in three personalities; the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, who are co-eternal in existence, co-equal in essence, and one in purpose.

Jesus Christ is the Only Savior of Men! By means of the incarnation, through the virgin birth, the second person of the trinity became the perfect Savior; wholly man and wholly God united in one person. The Son of God died a substitutionary death on the cross to redeem sinners, and rose bodily from the grave to give eternal life to all who believe in Him. He ascended to the right hand of the Father where he presently abides, and will come again in power and glory to receive and reward His own.

Man in his Natural State is Totally Depraved! Although created in the image of God, man by original sin has become the recipient of a sinful nature. As a result, man is sinfully enslaved in transgression, and without the provision of God's saving grace through Jesus Christ, is eternally lost.

SPEAKERS

Dr. John Soden - Currently Dr. Soden is a professor in the Bible and Theology Department of Lancaster Bible College, specializing in Old Testament studies, a position he has held since 1998. He has taught on both the undergrad and graduate levels in all of the Old Testament as well as hermeneutics and some pastoral ministries. Previously he was pastor of Arriola Bible Church near Cortez, Colorado for over 9 years. He received his B.S. from Biola University; and Th.M. and Ph.D. degrees from Dallas Theological Seminary emphasizing Semitics and OT studies. He grew up in Oregon in a pastor's family and has been interested in some sort of full time service to Christ since he was a teenager. After the doctoral program, the Lord provided a great place to grow and learn in ministry in Colorado. The pastorate was a wonderful experience but very difficult to leave, but teaching has always been a passion and a pleasure. He is married and has three grown children.

Lowell Hunking - Lowell Hunking is Crown Attorney for the County of Bruce in Ontario. Prior to joining the Crown's office, he practiced criminal and matrimonial law in private practice. Lowell is the former pastor of Sawgrass Community Church in Ft. Lauderdale, FL and a former police officer. He continues to preach as pulpit supply. He is married to Margy and they have two adult

daughters. Lowell writes a regular column for the Christian Legal Journal entitled "Law and Grace" and is host of a weekly radio show of the same name, where lawyers are interviewed regarding their faith, their work and the issues that God has them involved in on behalf of the faith.

Dr. William E. Rice - William (Willy) Rice is the pastor of the Calvary Baptist Church in Clearwater, Florida. Dr. Rice served as President of the Florida Baptist Convention from 2006-2008. He is the author of two books; *Discover Dynamic Life* and *Before You Go: What Every Parent Needs to Say and Every Kid Needs to Hear*. Before coming to Calvary, Dr. Rice pastored the Hillcrest Baptist Church in Pensacola for seven years. Prior to pastoring Hillcrest, Dr. Rice had pastored the Gladeview Baptist Church in Anniston, Alabama, the Cypress Lake Baptist Church in Tampa, Florida and the Bethel Baptist Church in Dora, Alabama. In 2004 he returned to the Tampa Bay area where he was born and raised to lead the church he considered his home church. Dr. Rice is a graduate of Samford University in Birmingham, Alabama with a B.A. degree and the New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary with a Master of Divinity degree and a Doctor of Ministry degree. He is married to Cheryl who is also a graduate of Samford University and they have three children and one grandchild.

Dr. Bruce Gerlach serves as our Camp Music Director. He is a gifted musician with a Doctorate in Music from Southern Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky. Bruce is Professor of Music and Chairman of the Fine Arts Division at the College of the Ozarks in Missouri. His giftedness and earnest desire to involve people in worship combine to inspire great singing and meaningful worship at each of our services. Bruce has been part of camp since childhood. He and his wife, Margie, have two children.

CONCERT

Larnelle Harris - The only person in history to be a member of the Gospel Music Hall of Fame, the Kentucky Music Hall of Fame and the Amateur Radio Hall of Fame is 5-time Grammy and 11-time Dove Award winner Larnelle Harris. In addition to his Grammy and Dove Awards, including being named Male Vocalist of the Year three times by the gospel music industry, Harris has garnered *nineteen #1* national radio singles and countless top 10 hits. From the White House to the 38th Parallel, Larnelle has impacted audiences across the globe with his music. He was the first gospel artist to perform inside the Kremlin after the fall of the Soviet Union. In addition to his musical career, Harris has been an avid amateur radio operator for over 20 years. Married to wife Cynthia (a.k.a Mitzy) for over 40 years, Harris continues to tour worldwide. In addition to his numerous solo dates, Harris also travels with various tours including the Gaither Homecoming tour, the God Of All Glory Tour, The Big 3 tour, and the Sandi Patty and Friends tour. Harris has appeared on several national TV shows and networks.
