



1. NAME/HOW LONG HAVE YOU ATTENDED CMC? WHAT WERE THE CIRCUMSTANCES THAT BROUGHT YOU HERE?

–My name is Millie Weidman. I am 86 yrs. old. I have been coming to camp since 1946 and have never missed. My husband, Eugene, was the spiritual director for 10 years. (He was the first layman to hold that position. The men who preceded him were all ordained ministers.) He passed away in 1999. We first had a tent and then moved into our cottage in 1964.

2. COULD YOU SHARE A FEW MEMORIES OF EARLIER TIMES AT CAMP?

–At 14 yrs. old, I was saved under the ministry of Dr. Andy Telford. Mrs. Telford explained the plan of salvation to me and I prayed to receive Christ. When she asked me if I knew I was going to heaven, I said, “i hope so.” At that, she began to explain everything again!

–I brought all three girls to camp for the entire week when Lisa was only 6 mos old. We hung diapers out on the porch. There were no showers. There was a dress code and the girls had to dress up for children’s service. I made them multiple matching outfits.

–The dress code also applied to those on the platform. Getting Eugene ready for camp was interesting because of this. I had his clothes all lined up for each day labeled for a.m. and p.m.! This was especially tricky for us because his normal day-to-day wardrobe was all about being on the job as a builder!

3. WHAT ARE YOUR THOUGHTS ABOUT THE LEGACY AND LONGEVITY OF CAMP?

–Camp has always maintained a strong gospel ministry. My favorite speakers over the years were Dr. Telford and Dr. Hubbard.
